DDG KINGPOST COVER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Please review instructional DVD provided to your CIWS technicians. The DVD was produced specifically for CIWS covers, but the principles of use and care & maintenance of the covers is the same for all Envelop covers.
- 2) Unfasten nylon buckles and Velcro seam on the back of the cover.
- 3) Carry the cover to the mezzanine deck above the Kingpost.
- 4) Slide the cover on to the King post from above with the ship's name facing outboard.
- 5) Fasten rear seam buckles & velcro from top to bottom.
- 6) Fasten bottom nylon buckle and cinch strap snugly around the base of the kingpost.
- 7) Installation complete.
- 8) Keep the cover on the equipment as much as possible. It will reduce corrosion significantly by keeping the equipment dry and due to the Vapor Corrosion Inhibitors built into the cover. The cover is effective even if it gets wet because it wicks moisture away from the equipment and it will dry out itself with time.
